Procedure

To highlight some of the Global Goals for Sustainable Development Issues each subject department agrees to explore one issue with each year group per year. EACH DEPARTMENT picks a month so student awareness is raised all year round. Suggested themes are:

- 1. Investigating ways of managing conflict and promoting community relations and reconciliation
- 2. Investigating local and global scenarios where human rights have been seriously infringed
- 3. Investigating how and why some people may experience inequality and social exclusion on the basis of their material circumstances in local and global contexts
- 4. Exploring the work of organisations that aim to promote equality and social justice
- 5. Investigating various ways to participate in school and society
- 6. Investigating an issue from a range of viewpoints and suggesting actions that might be taken to improve or resolve the situation
