Procedure

To learn about each other in a very simple way, schools can run an initiative to promote a healthy eating policy or even incorporate this into intercultural week.

The school could serve healthy snacks from a different culture once a month or once a week. Some ideas to get started are:

- 1. Think about planning healthy snacks from around the world.
- 2. Consider what snacks are healthy in different countries.
- 3. Make a fruit and vegetable platter for snack time. Discuss the colour, texture and taste of known and new snacks.
- 4. Students explore how to take care of their bodies through healthy eating.
