<p><b>Procedure</b></p> <p>To highlight the Global Goals for Sustainable Development Issues the Music department agrees to explore an issue with each year group in the following way:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Listen to pieces of music and songs that address global issues like poverty/gender equality/good health/wellbeing</li> <li>2. Compose music which expresses students' own personal responses to themes and issues</li> <li>3. Explore issues related to education for sustainable development</li> </ol>
