<p>Procedure</p> <p>To learn about the contributions of others from different countries in each subject field:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teachers can research Home Language Role Models in their subject area (authors, poets, scientists, explorers, inventors, artists, musicians, etc.) 2. Students are asked to think about other famous people from their or other countries who have made positive contributions to our community/the wider community/the world 3. Students reflect on and consider positive change and how we all have a responsibility to make an active contribution <p>Students can research in their home languages.</p>
